**Re: Hurricane Harvey Repairs**

Dear VOL Residents:

We hope that those of you that were impacted by Hurricane Harvey are doing well and are able to be back in your homes.

To allow ample time for repairs to the homes that were damaged by Hurricane Harvey, The Village of Oak Lake HOA Board of Directors has observed a grace period on Deed Restrictions related to construction issues and debris removal.

**It has now been nine months since Harvey, and the grace period for Deed Restriction deviations on Harvey-related issues (debris removal, construction issues, storage and trash receptacles) is set to expire at the end of this month (June 30).**

We are asking those residents, who are still repairing their homes to start cleaning-up debris from the exterior of the homes, haul off trailers parked in driveways and/or streets and ensure that general maintenance on the exterior of the home is taking place.

*Construction debris will not be removed by regular trash service.* If you need additional time to take care of these things, please contact us and provide us with the timeframe needed.
